

# NCLB Military Recruitment “Opt Out” Form

Federal public law 107-110, section 9528 of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act, “No Child Left Behind Act” requires school districts to release student names, addresses and phone numbers to military recruiters upon request. The law also requires the school district to notify students and parents of the right to “Opt-Out” by requesting that the district not release their students’ information to military recruiters. This form is intended to serve as a request to withhold this information.

**If you do not return this completed/signed form to your high school office by OCTOBER 15th your contact information will be provided to military recruiters.**

As a student/parent/legal guardian, I am exercising the right to “**opt-out**” and request that you do not provide the name, address and telephone number of the following student’s to military recruiters.
